

BEEF LIVER REMEDY FOR FADING PUPPIES

This is an old remedy, but seems to work wonders.

Take a large piece of beef liver, add a little bit of water, and boil slowly, about 5 minutes, until the blood comes out. Let cool, drain the liquid and put just 4 drops (no matter the breed) into a dropper and give to puppy.

At first you give it every 2 hours for 12 hours, then every 4 hours. Continue until you feel the puppy is thriving.

Don't use any of the liver itself, it's way too rich, just the liquid.
